

**LOCAL LAW 3 OF 2005**  
**A LOCAL LAW AMENDING LOCAL LAW #1 OF 1990 - SIGN LAW,**  
**ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM SIGN HEIGHT IN COMMERCIAL ZONES**  
**ADOPTED AUGUST 11, 2005**

Section 1. Findings.

The Village of Horseheads Board of Trustees has heretofore enacted Local Law #1 of 1990, the Village of Horseheads "Sign Law". Over the years, said law has been applied throughout the Village. Recently the Planning Board and Board of Trustees have reviewed the height limitation of signs, in particular in connection with construction of I86 through the Village. As a result of such review it has been determined that the height of signs throughout the Village should be amended as hereinafter set forth.

Section 2. Amendment.

Local Law #1 of 1990, Sign Law, Section 13-7(c), Height, is deleted in its entirety. Said provision is hereby amended to read as follows:

No sign placed in a C-1, C-2, C-3 or M-1 zoning district shall be higher than 35 feet. Further all signs or advertising structures are subject to further restrictions of height as herein specified.

Section 3. Repealer. Any local law, ordinance or resolution of the Village in conflict herewith is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency, except that this repeal shall not effect or prevent the prosecution or punishment of any person for any act done or committed in violation of any local law, ordinance, or regulation hereby repealed prior to the effective date of this local law.

Section 4. Severability. In the event any clause, sentence, section or other part of this local law is declared to be invalid, such invalidity shall not effect the remainder of this law.

Section 5. Effective Date. This local law shall take effect as provided by law.

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
